

Matthew 10:1-16

1 Jesus sends out the Twelve

Gives them authority over impure spirits and every disease and sickness.

2-4 Names of the 12 apostles

9-10 What to take or not take for the journey:

No gold or silver or copper,
no bag,
no extra shirt,
no sandals,
no staff;
for laborers deserve their food.

11-14 How to behave in houses and towns:

"Whatever town or village you enter, search there for some worthy person and stay at their house until you leave. As you enter the home, give it your greeting. If the home is deserving, let your peace rest on it; if it is not, let your peace return to you."
"If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, leave that home or town and shake the dust off your feet."

Mark 6:7-13

7 Jesus sends out the Twelve two by two

Gives them authority over impure spirits.

8-9 What to take or not take for the journey:

"Take nothing . . . except a staff—
no bread,
no bag,
no money in your belts.
Wear sandals
but not an extra shirt."

10-11 How to behave in houses and towns:

"Whenever you enter a house, stay there until you leave that town."
"And if any place will not welcome you or listen to you, leave that place and shake the dust off your feet as a testimony against them."

12-13 What the disciples did

"Preached that people should repent . . . drove out many demons . . . anointed many . . . and healed them."

Luke 9:1-6

1 Jesus sends out the Twelve

Gives them power and authority over
demons and diseases

2 and to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal.

3 What to take or not take for the journey:

"Take nothing . . .
no staff,
no bag,
no bread,
no money
no extra shirt."

4-5 How to behave in houses and towns:

"Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that town."
"If people do not welcome you, leave their town and shake the dust off your feet as a testimony against them."

6 What the disciples did

"So they set out and went from village to village, proclaiming the good news and healing people everywhere."

Luke 10:1-20

1 Jesus sends out 72 others in pairs

4 What to take or not take for the journey:

no purse,
no bag,
no sandals;
"Do not greet anyone on the road."

5-7a, 10-11 How to behave in houses and towns:

"When you enter a house, first say, 'Peace to this house.' If someone who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you. Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages."
"But when you enter a town and are not welcomed, go into its streets and say, 'Even the dust of your town we wipe from our feet as a warning to you. Yet be sure of this: The kingdom of God has come near.'"
